What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files sent to a web browser by a web server and are stored on the receiving device.

There are various types of Cookies:

- Session Cookies automatically deleted at the end of each browsing session (typically when the web browser is closed);
- Persistent Cookies remain until the expiry date and time set by the web server (or otherwise manually deleted by the user);
- 1st Party Cookies originate from the same domain as the website being visited;
- 3rd Party Cookies originate from a domain that is different to the website being visited.

How does Keystone Underwriting Pty Ltd (Keystone) use cookies?

Keystone uses Cookies in two ways to:

- assign visitors to a Keystone website(s) a unique session identity in the form of a randomly generated combination of characters. This allows Keystone to track browsers in a unique method within and across one or more browsing sessions. Keystone does this for a variety of reasons and the list below explains these in detail. It is important to note however, that these Cookies do not contain any personal information and cannot be used by themselves to identify individual users; and
- 2. store website user preferences, either explicit or implied.

Cookies used by Keystone's website(s)

Keystone has grouped together the Cookies according to how they are used:

A) System Cookies

1. Content management and navigation to:

- provide easy and simple site navigation; or
- enable product search, identification, and e-commerce functions; or
- ensure you are not invited to complete a questionnaire that you have already completed or have told Keystone that you do not want to see again.

2. Content optimisation to:

- allow Keystone to tailor its content to match your preferences, for example, to show a button that allows you to retrieve a saved insurance quotation or semi-completed application form; or
- ensure you are not shown duplicate content as you navigate Keystone's website(s); or
- ensure consistency of content if you return to a Keystone website(s).



B) Web analytics Cookies

- Used to compile website usage statistics anonymously to help Keystone maintain and improve the performance of a Keystone website(s) and to allow Keystone to maximise opportunity.
- Keystone only use Cookies for the purposes stated above and where necessary for the provision of a specific service or functionality that you have requested from Keystone (for example logging into a secure area to complete an application or obtaining or retrieving an insurance quotation).

Keystone may have included links on a website(s) to other sites for your convenience that Keystone believes you may find useful. Please note any websites connected with this site are not within Keystone's control. These websites should have their own privacy statement, which may differ from Keystone's.
